Congress Approves PPP Flexibility Bill

Last night, the U.S. Senate gave final legislative approval to a bill to provide more flexibility for borrowers using PPP funds. President Trump is expected to sign the measure soon. A more detailed summary of the bill will be distributed once it is signed into law.

OSHA Reporting Requirements and COVID-19

Reversing prior guidance, OSHA has issued enforcement guidance that could make COVID-19 a recordable illness if it involves one or more of the recording criteria including hospitalization or death and is work-related. By way of background, since January 1, 2015, new car dealers are subject to OSHA reporting.
