COMPLIANCE WITH EXECUTIVE ORDER

- GADA has been informed that the Georgia State Patrol has randomly visited dealerships in the Atlanta area seemingly checking for compliance with the Governor's Executive Orders. Dealers are urged to review the [summary](#) and the most recent Executive Order to be sure dealerships are in compliance with requirements.
- On June 11, Governor Kemp issued a new Executive Order, which is in effect until June 30.
